Alejandro's Pisco Sour

R 125

The Pisco Sour, a South American classic, blends smooth pisco-distilled from fermented grape juice with fresh lime juice, simple syrup, and a touch of egg white (we use EEZE Foam for a modern twist). This cocktail quickly became a clandestine sensation, symbolizing sophistication and rebellion amidst the era's restrictions. Pisco was famously smuggled into the U.S. through elaborate schemes, adding to its allure and earning its place on secret menus throughout the city. Each glass embodies a spirit of freedom and elegance.

The Bubble Bath Gin Fizz

The Bubble Bath Gin Fizz adds a touch of sophistication to the 1920s cocktail scene with its intriguing frothy texture and enchanting fruity essence. Inspired by the clandestine production of homemade gin, this drink combines Bombay Sapphire, lime juice, and hints of melon, apple, and mint, offering a taste of hidden luxury and inventive mixology.



Midnight Flappers French 75

This sparkling cocktail pays tribute to the vibrant women of the Roaring Twenties, who embraced glamour and freedom. Blending Bombay Sapphire, fresh lemon juice, and simple syrup, then topped with Pongratz, it captures the exuberance and energy of lively gatherings, transporting you to a time of jazz, bold fashion, and spirited celebration.

Moonshine Mule

Moonshine, the infamous homemade spirit of the 1920s, represents a blend of ingenuity and resistance. Crafted in hidden stills, moonshine was known for its intense kick. Our Moonshine Mule honours this rebellious spirit by mixing smooth Grey Goose vodka with tangy lime juice fresh mint and spicy ginger beer.



Blue Envy

Blue Envy is an exquisite elixir featuring smooth, secretly imported Cazadores Blanco tequila paired with the vibrant richness of Butlers Blue and the tropical zest of pineapple extracts. Each sip reveals a hidden narrative of forbidden glamour and discreet indulgence.



The Speakeasy Sour

The Speakeasy Sour brings to life the allure of 1920s underground bars, where whisky was savoured despite the ban. This cocktail combines the rich, smoky flavours of Johnnie Walker Black Label with lemon juice and simple syrup, topped with a float of red wine to contrast the bold whisky. It honours the creativity that defined these secret venues.

The Muddled Old Fashioned

R 125

Celebrating the ingenuity of 1920s mixologists who improvised with available ingredients, this cocktail blends muddled orange, Maraschino cherries, and Amarena syrup with bourbon and soda water. It reflects the era's homemade charm and inventive flair. Enjoy a nostalgic sip that highlights resourcefulness and artisanal spirit. A not-to-miss experience.



Smoked Old Fashioned

Traditionally stirred and smoked with oak chips, this cocktail adds an extra layer of smokiness to your Old-Fashioned experience.



Scofflaw's Side Car

R 125

This cocktail emerged during Prohibition as a nod to those who openly flouted the ban on alcohol. Its name originates from a bar where patrons arrived on motorcycles with sidecars and demanded something robust and different. This cocktail has the perfect balance of rich Hennessy Cognac, Triple Sec, and tangy lemon. To sweeten the experience, we offer a sugar rim.

Twisted Painkiller

R 110

This innovative creation blends tropical flavours of Pineapple, Orange, and Coconut with a touch of Malibu and Slojo Strawberry coulis which adds fruity decadence while the robust Bacardi Negra dark rum adds richness to your drink. It's the perfect fusion of old-school charm and bold, adventurous twists. Ideal for those who enjoy juicy cocktails with a splash of excitement.



Rum Runner

R 100

A cocktail that was created in the 1950's at a tiki bar that had a surplus of rum and liqueurs. To move inventory, the owner concocted a unique cocktail. He named the drink after smugglers historically called "rum runners". The tropical cocktail that packs a punch is made with two types of rum - Bacardi Carta Blanca and Negra, Butler's banana and Bols blackcurrant, pineapple juice and grenadine. If you are craving a boozy cocktail, the rum runner is for you.





Jungle Bird

R 100

Sip carefully, as this drink may inspire a rebellious spirit of your own. Blending Bacardi Negra and Campari with pineapple and lime juice, this cocktail balances juicy and bold, bitter flavours. Imbued with a hint of forbidden allure, the Jungle Bird's vibrant flavours are best enjoyed in secrecy, sipped in the dim glow of the underground.

Bootleggers Boulevardier

R 100

The Bootlegger's Boulevardier pays homage to the audacious drinkers of the Prohibition Era, who defied the ban on alcohol with style. This spirit-forward cocktail blends Woodford Reserve bourbon, sweet vermouth, and Campari, embodying a sophisticated cocktail within your glass.



Gangsters Manhattan

R 115

This classic cocktail embodies the intrigue of the 1920s nightlife. Featuring a robust mix of Jack Daniels Straight Rye whiskey and sweet vermouth, accented with aromatic bitters. Let it transport you to a smoke-filled lounge, where the thrill of underground gatherings lingered in the air.

Smoke The God Father

R 120

Step into the world of the Godfather with our Smokey Smoldering Sipper. Combining Chivas Regal 12-Year-Old Scotch and Amaretto Disaronno, elevated with an oak-smoked finish, it offers the elegant taste of scotch rounded off with rich almond liqueur—a nod to the iconic figure that inspired it.



Rusty Nail

R 115

Utilizing Dewar's 12-Year-Old Scotch for its complexity and smoothness, The Rusty Nail features Drambuie, with its honeyed sweetness, perfectly complementing the whisky's character. The name "Rusty Nail" is thought to reflect the cocktail's rugged, uncomplicated nature. Some suggest that the "nail" refers to the drink's strong, lasting flavour, while others point to its rustic appearance.
